

CIRCULAR

Sub: Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for ST Students for the year 2022-23.

The Directorate of Tribal Welfare is implementing the Scheme namely:

The Scheme of "Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for ST Students belonging to Scheduled Tribes for studies in India.

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the Scheduled Tribe students studying at post matriculation or post-secondary stage of enable them to complete their education.

These scholarships are available for studies in India only and are awarded by the Government of the State/Union Territory Administration to which the applicant actually belongs i.e. where permanently settled.

- (i) The scholarships are open to Indian Nationals
- (ii) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognised post-matriculation for post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions with the following exceptions:

"Scholarships are not awarded for training course like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Courses and Private Pilot Licence courses, courses at Training – Ship Dufferin (Now Rajendra), courses of training at the Military College, Dehradun and courses at pre-examination training centres of all India and State levels.

Scholarships are available to the students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) per annum.

All eligible students shall compulsorily apply for the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for ST Students through National Scholarship Portal (NSP). Institutes with valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT code will be eligible to submit the KYC form on the National Scholarship Portal for registration. The KYC form shall be duly approved by District/State/Ministry Level Nodal Officer. Upon approval of the KYC form Institution shall update their profile on NSP, with all the courses that are currently being offered by the Institute. Also, the Institutes shall verify the details such as course selected, fees paid etc. submitted by the students while applying online on NSP. The verified applications shall be forwarded to the District/State/Ministry Nodal Officer.
