Actual program details

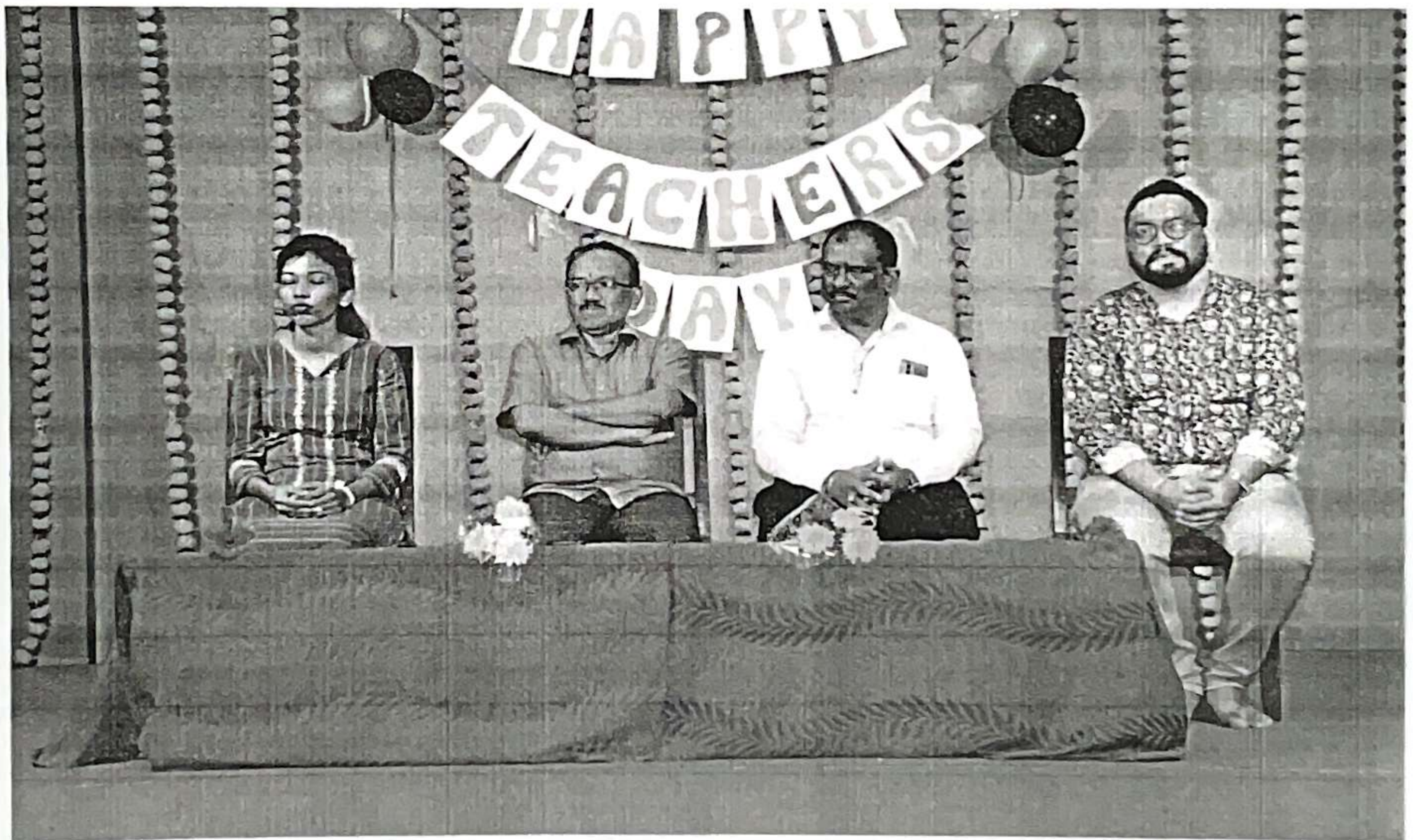







