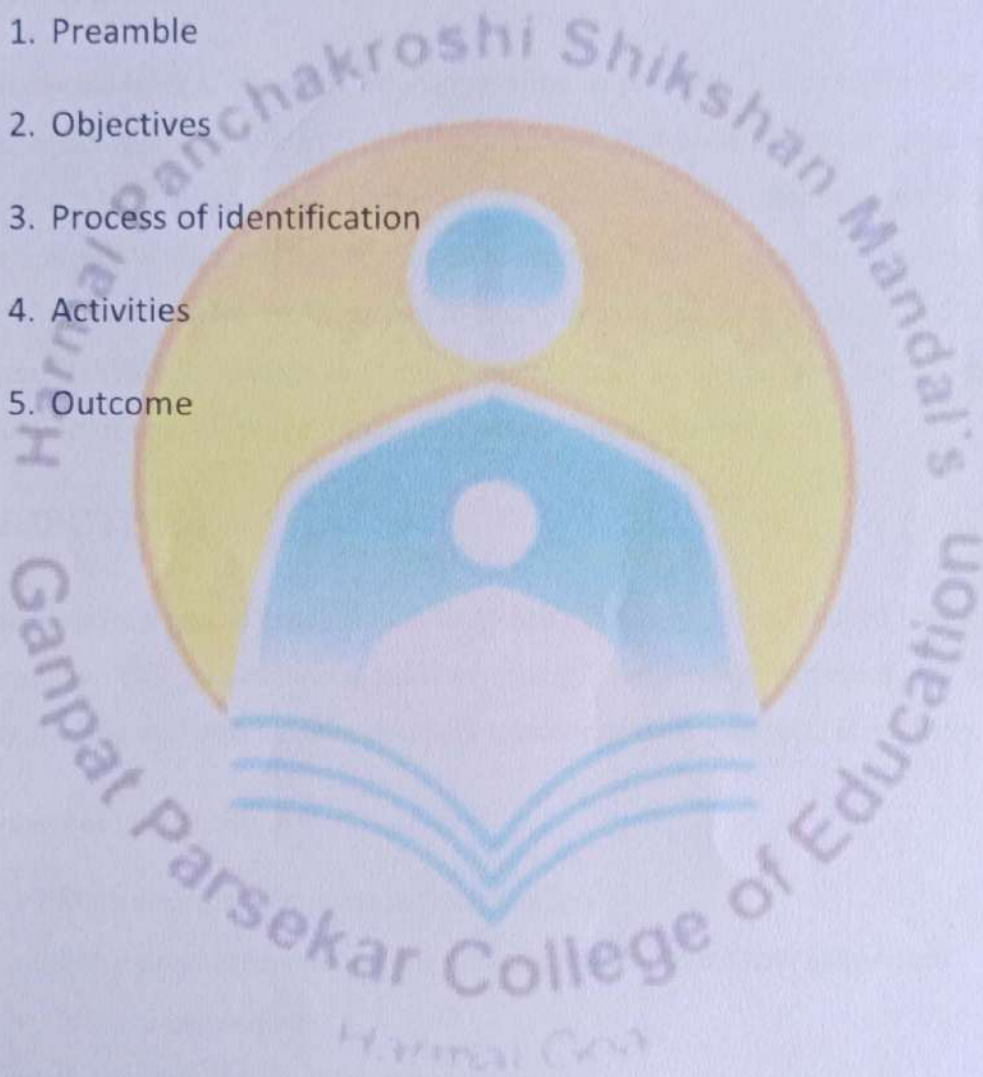
Guidelines For identifying and Activities - Student's

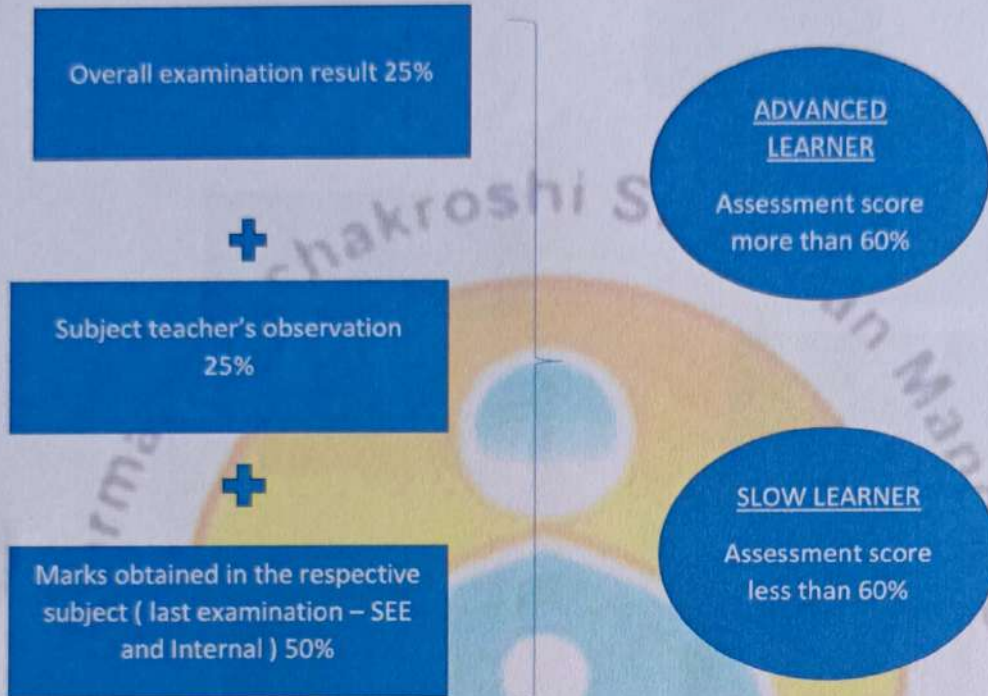
OBJECTIVES -

Process of identification –

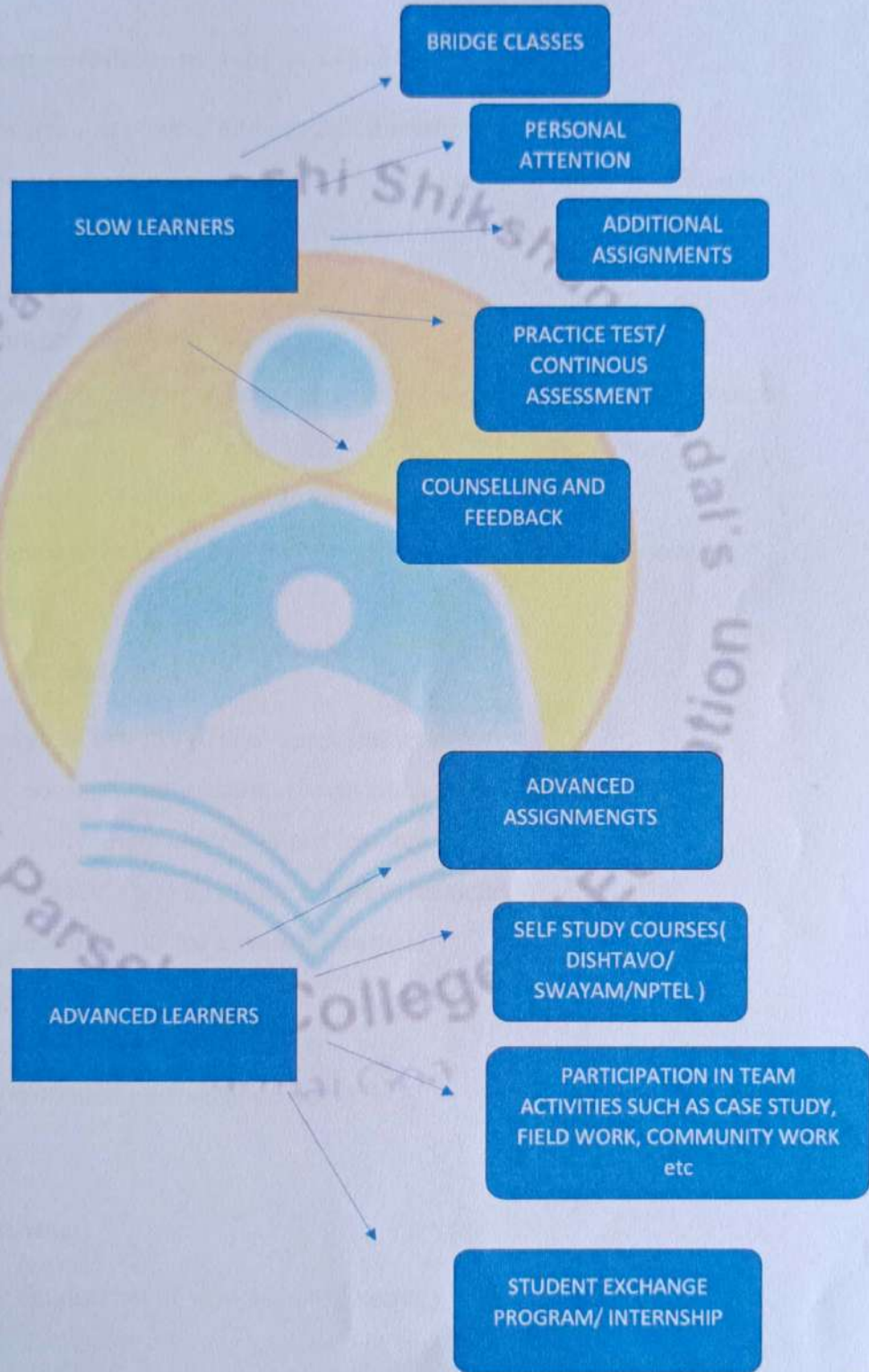
- Mark sheets of the previous examination
- Entry-level assessment using Standardised tests for new admissions
- Internal assessment
- Class observation of the subject teacher





- The subject teacher's observation should be recorded for the whole class on a scale of 1 to 10 (Each value = 10%).

ACTIVITIES –



Roles and Responsibilities of Subject Teacher:

- Identification of slow and advanced learners
- Preparation of schedule for extra classes/problem-solving sessions/ revision sessions for slow learners and maintenance of records
- Use of assessment tools
- Continuous assessment
- Preparation of a list of advanced assignments or task list for advanced learners
- Preparation of improvement reports
- Maintenance of activity outcome reports for slow and advanced learners

Documents to be maintained:

- I. Cover page of activity (Class wise/ Session wise)
- II. Internal assessment evaluation sheets and tabulation sheets
- III. List of slow learners and advanced learners
- IV. Activity schedule and timetable for slow learners
- V. List of activity tasks for advanced learners
- VI. Attendance records
- VII. Performance improvement reports
- VIII. Yearly compiled performance report

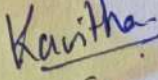
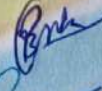
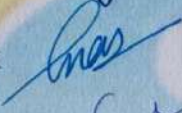
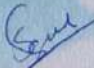
Expected outcome:
