

More Details of the Event:

The short-term certificate course committee of the college in collaboration with IQAC and different departments of the college took an initiative of organizing minimum 30 hours of value added course for the students of the F.Y./S.Y./FoY.B.A.B.Ed and B.ScB.Ed from 5th August 2023 to 30th March 2024. There was a specific manual standard and in the time table where every

The value-added courses aimed at providing additional skills and knowledge to the students besides their curriculum. All together 13 value added courses were organized out of which principles of organic, course on mushroom cultivation, Maintenance and Repair of Instruments; Study and Designing of Electronic Gadgets and Arduino and MEPSC-Career and Education Counsellor courses were organized in collaboration with different govt and private institutions. These initiatives have strengthened our links with other institutions. Other value-added courses were organized inhouse where faculties from other educational institutions acted as resources person to provide their expertise on the content.




