The competition encompassed multiple languages, including English, Marathi, Konkani, and Hindi.








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"Shakti in the Mahabharata: A Feminist Retelling" on 11/03/2024

Objectives:


- The explore the portrayal of feminine power within the narrative framework of the Mahabharata.

The Department of English at Ganpat Parsekar College of Education organized an insightful talk on the topic "Shakti in the Mahabharata: A Feminist Retelling" on the 11th of March 2024. The distinguished guest speaker for the event was Ms. Kshama Dharwadkar, an Assistant Professor in French, who shared her expertise on the various dimensions of the Mahabharata from a feminist perspective.

The talk garnered considerable interest, with a total of 55 students from the college attending the event. The enthusiastic participation of the students demonstrated a keen interest in exploring alternative perspectives on classical texts.



Ms. Dharwadkar initiated the talk by emphasizing the importance of approaching the Mahabharata with a multi-faceted lens. She encouraged the audience to consider the epic not as a singular narrative but as a text open to diverse interpretations.

The speaker delved into the portrayal of women in the Mahabharata, shedding light on the multifaceted roles and complexities of female characters. She discussed how these characters often embodied strength, resilience, and wisdom, challenging conventional stereotypes.

An intriguing aspect of the talk was the exploration of the subaltern voices within the Mahabharata. Ms. Dharwadkar highlighted the marginalized perspectives and voices often overlooked in traditional readings of the epic, providing a more inclusive understanding.

The speaker concluded by emphasizing the significance of retelling the Mahabharata from feminist viewpoints. She discussed how reinterpreting the narrative allows for a more nuanced understanding, offering a fresh and empowering perspective.





Feedback analyses on the talk "Shakti in Mahabharata: A Feminist Retelling"

The majority of respondents (50%) rated the talk as "Effective." while 14.7% found it "Very effective." Only one respondent found it "Very ineffective." This indicates that the majority found the talk to be at least somewhat effective in addressing the theme of "Shakti in the Mahabharata: A Feminist Retelling."

A resounding majority (91.2%) agreed that the speaker successfully connected the feminist perspective with the characters and events in the Mahabharata. This suggests that the speaker effectively tied feminist interpretations to the narrative of the Mahabharata.

While a significant portion (64.7%) felt that the talk moderately enhanced their understanding of the feminist interpretation of the Mahabharata, 23.5% felt it enhanced their understanding very much. Only a small percentage (8.8%) felt it had an extreme impact. Overall, it seems that the talk contributed positively to the audience's comprehension of the feminist retelling.

The vast majority (94.1%) either strongly agreed or agreed that the examples and references provided during the talk were clear and relevant in supporting the feminist retelling of the Mahabharata. This indicates that the audience found the supporting material effective in bolstering the speaker's arguments.

The most common suggestions for improvement included making the talk more interactive, incorporating videos or multimedia elements into the presentation, and delivering the content in a more engaging storytelling format rather than simply reading from a script. Some respondents also expressed a desire for more in-depth knowledge and additional visual aids, such as pictures or documentaries, to enhance the session's appeal.

Overall, while the talk was generally well-received and deemed effective in conveying the feminist interpretation of the Mahabharata, there is room for improvement in terms of interactivity, multimedia integration, and presentation style to further engage the audience and enhance the learning experience.


