

SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGHER STUDIES

1) Objective:

The Goa Hindu association awards special scholarships to financially needy students of Goan Origin only to enable them to pursue studies in Engineering, Medical, Pharmacy, Agriculture, Architecture and similar disciplines after passing Higher Secondary Examination.

Once a student is selected for the award of this scholarship, generally, it is continued every year to enable the student to complete the course, provided the student passes every year. In case of failure the scholarship is discontinued. The student is expected to apply for the scholarship every year and submit the documents listed below along with the application.

The details of the scheme are as follows.

2) Eligibility:

- i) The student must be of Goan origin.
- ii) Parents income from all sources should be below Rs 4,00,000 (4lakh) per annum.
- iii) The students must have passed HSSC examination with a minimum of 65% marks in aggregate and secured admission in a state/central government/university approved college/institute.

3) Scholarship Amount: Rs 12000/- per year approx.

4) Documents to be furnished:

- i) Xerox copy of proof of income. (Salary Certificate issued by employer or income certificate certified by a competent authority such as Collector, Block Development Officer, Magistrate, Mamlatdar, or Affidavit of the Guardian).
- ii) Xerox copy of bonafide student certificate from college/institute or fee receipt as proof of having taken admission
- iii) Xerox copy of statement of marks of HSSC examination.

(Xerox copies of the above must be attested by any of the following authorities. Teaching faculty i.e. Lecturer, Asst Professor, Professor, Principal etc. of the college/institute where the student is studying, Registrar of the college, Gazetted Officer etc.)

- 5) Managing committee reserves the rights to alter or modify the above guidelines, and in all matters concerning this scholarship its decision will be final.
- 6) Declaration by the Parent/Guardian of the applicant thatHe/She has read and accepted rules and regulations relating to this scholarship and that the information furnished in the application by his/her ward is authentic.

Note: Incomplete applications will be rejected without giving any reason.
