Details of the visit:

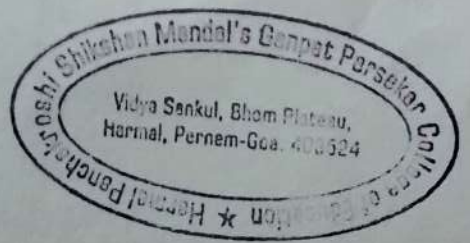
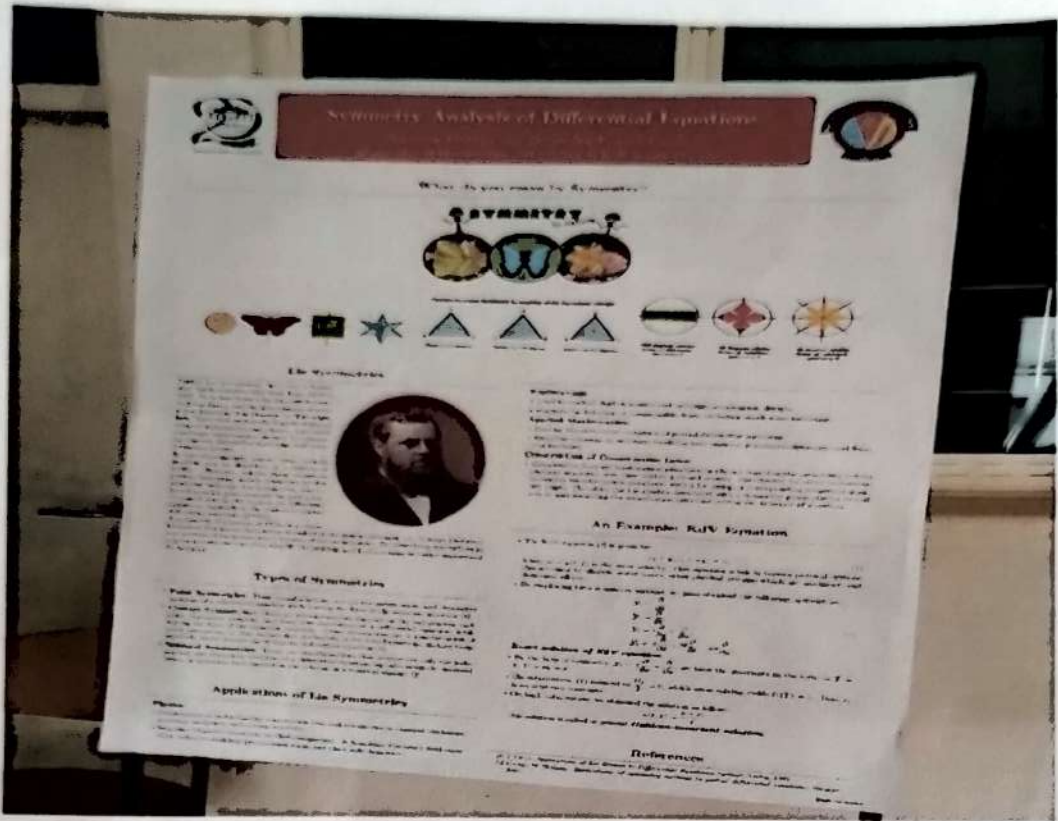
