

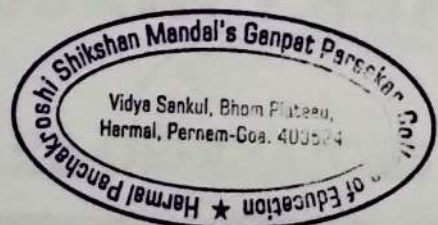

### DAY 1 : 26th November 2023 -- GOA - BHOPAL

Leave for Bhopal from Madgaon railway station at 1.20 am.

### DAY 2 : 27th November 2023 -- BHOPAL - SANCHI

Reach Bhopal railway station at 3.20 am. Check-in at hotel.

After breakfast, leave for Sanchi. On arrival visit the beautiful **SANCHI STUPA**, a UNESCO World Heritage site, one of the oldest stone structures in India and is considered to be one of the finest examples of Buddhist architecture and art, built by the Mauryan Emperor Ashoka. Later proceed to Bhopal.

In the evening, visit the majestic **GAUHAR MAHAL**, a palace that reflects the fusion of Hindu and Mughal architectural styles. Explore the nearby **SHAUKAT MAHAL**, a beautiful blend of European and Islamic influences.

Visit the **STATE MUSEUM OF MADHYA PRADESH**, which houses a vast collection of artifacts, sculptures, and paintings that depict the rich history and culture of the region. Night halt at Bhopal.

### DAY 3 : 28th November 2023 -- BHOJPUR- BHIMBETKA

After breakfast, leave for Bhojpur. Visit incomplete **BHOJESHWAR TEMPLE** dedicated to Shiva and marvel at its magnificent architecture.

Afterwards head towards to Bhimbetka caves. **BHIMBETKA ROCK SHELTER** is one of the UNESCO Heritage site which has 243 rock shelters with paintings depicting things of prehistoric Palaeolithic and Mesolithic periods.

Later proceed to Indore. Night halt at Indore.

### DAY 4 : 29th November 2023 -- INDORE

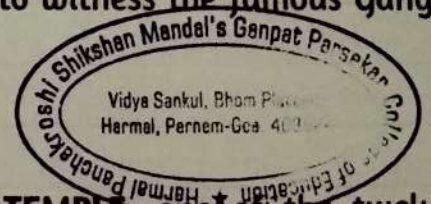
Start your day by visiting the iconic **RAJWADA PALACE**, a historical landmark that showcases the grandeur of the Holkar dynasty. Explore the intricate architecture and learn about the rich history of the region. Then visit the **KANCH MANDIR**, also known as the Glass Temple, famous for its stunning glasswork and mirror mosaics. Admire the intricate designs and beautiful craftsmanship of this unique temple.

In afternoon, explore the **CENTRAL MUSEUM**, which houses a vast collection of artifacts and artworks from different periods of history. Learn about the rich cultural heritage of Madhya Pradesh through the exhibits on display. Then, visit the **LAL BAGH PALACE**, a magnificent palace built in the 19th century. Explore the opulent interiors, beautiful gardens, and the museum showcasing artifacts and belongings of the Holkar dynasty.

Later, head to Ujjain. On arrival, visit the **RAM GHAT** to witness the famous Ganga Aarti on the banks of the Shipra river. Night halt at Ujjain.

Start your day by visiting the **MAHAKALESHWAR TEMPLE**, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas dedicated to the Lord Shiva. Walk through **MAHAKAL CORRIDOR** – the largest corridor in India. Later, visit **BADA GANESH**, **KAAL BHAIRAV TEMPLE** and **HARISIDDHI MATA TEMPLE** – one of the 51 shaktipeeths of India.



In afternoon, visit **JANTAR MANTAR**, an ancient astronomical observatory. Marvel at the precision and complexity of the instruments used to track celestial movements. Take a guided tour to learn about the significance of each instrument and the history behind them.

Later, head to the **SANDIPANI ASHRAM**, a renowned educational and cultural center. Learn about the ancient Vedic traditions and participate in the spiritual activities conducted at the ashram.

In the evening, leave for Surat from Ujjain railway station at 6.55 pm.  
Night halt at Surat.

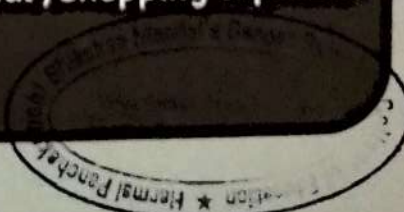
In the evening, leave for Goa from Surat railway station at 7.34 pm.

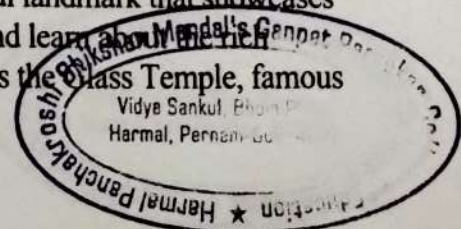
