More details on Intercollegiate Oral Presentation Competition on "Science Experiential Learning in Konkani"

- Each institution may send only one team, consisting of two B.Sc. students.
- The team should select one topic or concept from the undergraduate science curriculum and explain it in Konkani, using the concept of experiential learning.
- The explanation should be in Konkani; however, technical terms should be stated in English. For example, an "atom" should be referred to as "atom" and not "anu".
- The team may include demonstrations, participative learning, models, etc., to enhance the understanding of the concept.
- The lesson should be accompanied by a PowerPoint presentation.
- Time: 8-12 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for the question-and-answer session (in Konkani).
- Teams should bring all required materials. However, in certain cases, the organizers may supply the necessary items upon prior request.
- Safety must be prioritized.
