

The Department of Botany of our college had organized an educational field trip on 2nd February 2025 for the 40 students of F.Y.B.Sc.B.Ed (CBZ) & S.Y.B.Sc.B.Ed (CBZ). The trip aimed to provide hands-on learning experiences in plant cultivation and conservation. The students visited the Strawberry Farm in Verlem-Netravali, followed by an excursion to the Salaulim Botanical Garden. The trip was guided by Ms. Akshatra Fernandes and Ms. Sukhada Salkar. The first stop was at Strawberry Farm where students learned about the cultivation practices of strawberries in Goa's climate. Students observed different growth stages of strawberry plants along with other ornamental flowering plants and vegetable crops grown in the farm. They also had the opportunity to taste freshly harvested strawberries. The next destination was the Salaulim Botanical Garden, which houses a rich

collection of native and exotic plant species. The students explored various sections of the garden, including medicinal plants, orchids, ferns, and aquatic plants. The visit helped students to better understand the diversity of plant life and importance of biodiversity conservation. The trip was both educational and enjoyable that enhanced the student's practical knowledge of botany.
