DAY 5: UDAIPUR

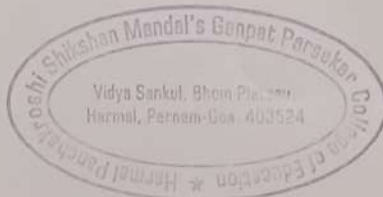

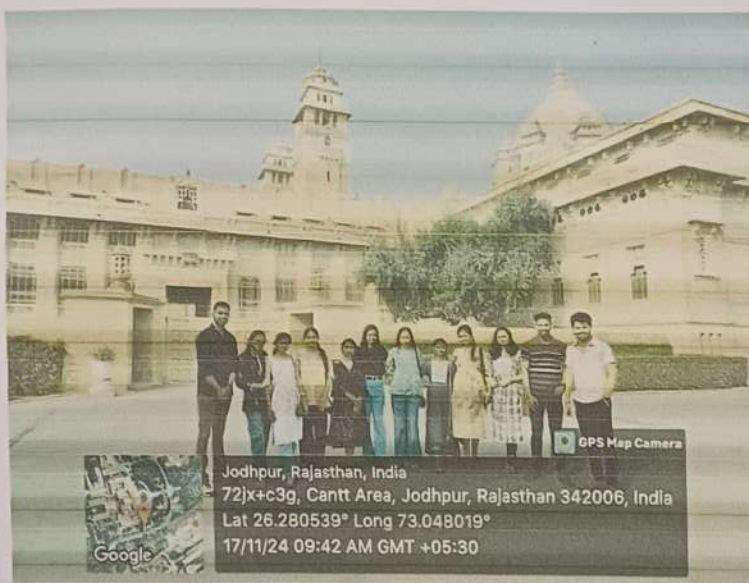
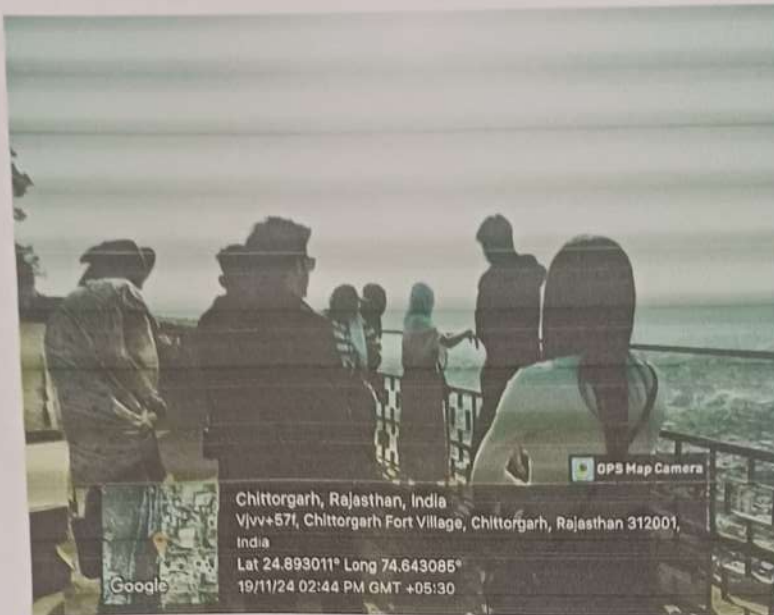
DAY 7: SURAT - GOA

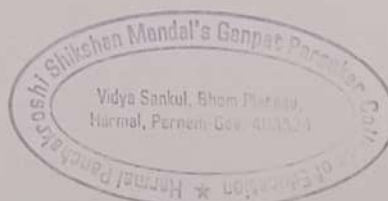
