
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
NOTICE

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


Report on ICT Tools for Teaching Learning Introduction

On 16th December 2024, the TLET Cell of Harmal Panchakroshi Shikshan Mandal's Ganpat Parsekar College of Education successfully organized a one-day workshop titled "ICT Tools for Teaching Learning" for the students of Final Year B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. The primary objective of this initiative was to enhance the digital literacy of pre-service teachers and equip them with relevant ICT tools that can be effectively utilized in modern classroom teaching. Recognizing the growing importance of technology integration in education, the workshop aimed to provide hands-on experience and expose student-teachers to the practical application of digital resources in instructional settings.




The resource person for the session was Mr. Vishwesh Fatrekar and Dr. Akshay Salkar. The session focused on demonstrating a variety of ICT tools that support interactive teaching, digital assessment, content creation, and online collaboration. Tools such as Google Classroom, Kahoot, Padlet, Canva, and Microsoft Forms were introduced, along with free and open-source educational platforms. Students were guided through real-time applications and were encouraged to create sample digital learning materials during the session. The emphasis was on using these platforms to design engaging and student-centered lesson plans, interactive quizzes, digital worksheets, and video-based instructional modules.

The workshop was conducted in a physical mode and witnessed enthusiastic participation from the final-year students across both streams. The resource inputs and technical guidance were provided by faculty members of the TLET Cell, with special attention to helping students navigate the user interface and functionalities of each tool. The workshop also covered aspects related to safe and ethical use of technology in classrooms, digital citizenship, and accessibility considerations while designing ICT-supported learning activities.

This training session served as a foundational experience for future educators to integrate digital strategies in their professional practice. It was observed that students actively engaged in collaborative tasks, shared creative outputs, and participated in peer feedback sessions during the workshop. The overall response from participants was overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing increased confidence in using technology to enhance their teaching effectiveness. The workshop proved to be a timely and impactful intervention aligned with the vision of National Education Policy (NEP 2020), which emphasizes digital empowerment and technological integration in teacher education.






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Was the instructor engaging and clear in their explanations?




